Description

We will explore both drawing and painting in one class. Students will learn the basics of both drawing and painting working with both drawing materials and watercolor, or tempera, or acrylic paint. They will learn how to take a creative idea from thought to artwork. We will choose a theme to work from for the entire class.



Ages

Elementary or Middle School

Class Outline:

Class One: Drawing Basics

Students will learn the basics of drawing by learning contour line drawing, basic shape drawing and some basic shading.

Class Two: Drawing Basics

During this class students will learn about drawing negative space and texture, and engage in a fun drawing game. Students should bring something to draw for next class.

Class Three: Color Drawing

Students will have the opportunity to work in color with color drawing materials including pastel and colored pencil. Students will be asked to bring something to draw.

Class Four: Painting Basics

Students will learn several basic watercolor, tempera, or acrylic techniques during this class.



Class Five: Painting Project

Students will have the opportunity to use what they learned painting during the previous week's class in a watercolor project.



Class Six (and beyond)

Students will continue to finish their paintings and drawings during these classes.
