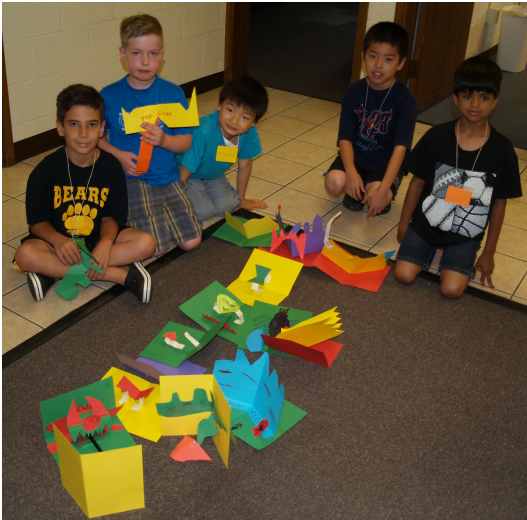


Pop-up Creations

Description

Students have fun problem solving by learning how to create pop-up designs. They will be guided through the process of making several different pop-up designs. They will learn how to cut out and fold designs and then decorate them with several different media. Students will learn how to think through a pop-up problem and then create it. In the end of the class students will be encouraged to create their own pop-up book stories.



Learning Objectives

Students will learn basic problem solving skills through the pop-up designs that they learn by thinking through a pop-up problem and then creating it. They will then be encouraged to create some fun pop-up characters and then create a book with these characters in it.

Grade Level

Grades 2-3 or 4-5

Syllabus

Class 1: Pop-up Cards

Students will learn a several simple pop-up techniques and create pop-up cards and a pop-up character.

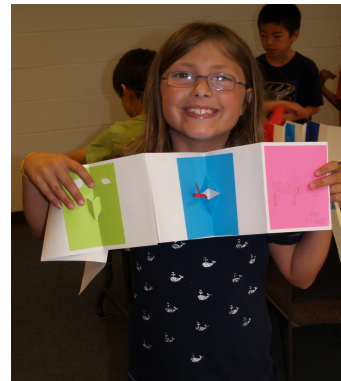


Class 2: Floating Pop-ups

Students will learn floating pop-up techniques.

Class 3: Accordion Books

Students will learn how to make an accordion book and create a story in it.



Class 4: Accordion Pop-Up Books

We will discuss the ideas as a group and offer suggestions for some pop-up stories that the students can do. We will look at some pop-up books by other artists.

Students will make another accordion book and plan the story for that book. They will be encouraged to use as many of the pop-up, that they had learned, as possible.

Class 5: Accordion Books Finished

Students will finish their books and work together to create a pop-up wonderland to share at the end of the class.

Class 6 (and beyond): Story Completed

Students will create more books and cards with pop-ups in them.
